Submission of abstract / research paper:

An abstract (maximum one page) is required for each presentation or poster presentation by October 19, 2015.

**Abstract format**: abstracts should be prepared using standard PC based MS Word software. Abstracts can be in English or Punjabi and cannot exceed one page. Use an 12-point Times New Roman and leave 1-inch margins left, rights, top and bottom. Center the title (maximum 12 words, all caps, bold type) at the top of the page.

Leave a blank line before beginning the author list, which is also to be centered. If several authors are from one organization, save space and make list easier to be read by grouping authors so that the organization needs to be typed once. Bold and italicized the presenting author. Leave a blank line after the authors and then begin the text typing it single-spaced and justifying left margin.

Papers can be submitted as full length or as an abstract by due dates. Manuscripts should be types in MS Word in Times New Roman font on A4 size sheet. The font size should be as follows: Title (14 points, Bold, Centered), Authors name 910 points, Bold, Centered), Heading and Subheading (12 points, Bold, Left Justified), Text (12 points Normal, both sides justified with 1" margin) and Figures and Tables captions (10 points, Bold, Centered). Manuscript must be submitted in soft copy and printed formats..
