#### **Brief Report of Activities:**

## Day-1 on 25<sup>th</sup> July 2019

- 1. Welcome session: It was the first day which has been designed to welcome and acquaint the incoming batch with the institute as a whole. Teachers shared their views with the students and tried to create friendly environment for classroom and tried to approach their emotional, educational needs.
- **6. College visit:** A.P. Ramanjeet Kaur along with first year students visited the different sites of the college such as Sports complex (Auditorium), sports ground, medicinal garden, animal house, hostel, gym, dispensary, sister institute Pharmacy college, office etc. and tried to familiarise with college environment.
- **7. Library visit:** Library is an important part of college education. A.P. Ramanjeet Kaur went with the students at 2.45 PM in college library. She familiarised the students with rules and regulations of the library and students got to know about the procedure to issue and return of books. Liberian Mrs.

- 1. Chemistry lab visit: Morning session started with the chemistry lab visit. A.P. Himani Saini and lab attended Mr. Sohan Singh told about rules and regulations of chemistry lab. Mr. Sohan Singh familiarised the students with the name of commonly used chemicals in chemistry lab. Lab coats were also distributed to the students of non-medical stream.

She encouraged the students to participate in such activities.


