Classroom Facilities

Requests for improved seating arrangements and the installation of curtains in classrooms on the new floor.

Seating arrangements were upgraded, and curtains were installed in the classrooms on the new floor as per student feedback.

Teaching and Learning

While the quality of teaching was appreciated, there was a suggestion for increased use of modern teaching tools and techniques.

Faculty were encouraged to participate in online training sessions on digital tools and innovative teaching methods. They also attended NPTEL courses, IKS workshops,

**Administrative Staff** 

Concerns regarding delays in service requests and the accessibility of administrative support.

A meeting was held by the Principal with administrative staff to address these concerns. A feedback mechanism was implemented to monitor and improve staff performance.

Cleanliness

Concerns raised regarding the cleanliness of drinking water facilities and washroom maintenance.

Regular maintenance schedules for water coolers and washrooms were established. In collaboration with an NGO, additional Reverse Osmosis (RO) systems were installed on campus to improve water quality.

Library Resources

Requests for additional textbooks to meet student needs.

Department-level book banks were created to support students, particularly those requiring financial assistance.

Communication

Delays in providing timely updates on institutional changes.

A structured communication system was implemented to ensure timely updates are provided through social media platforms and notice boards. Additionally, a new, user-friendly website is under development.

Student Comfort

Requests for replacement fans in classrooms on the top New fans were installed in the affected classrooms. A phased plan for the

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floor, particularly to address heat during warmer weather. installation of air conditioning in key areas has also been initiated.

**Extracurricular Activities** 

Moderate levels of participation in extracurricular activities. Theatre workshops and other engaging activities were organized to encourage greater student participation. A proposal for the establishment of a new NCC Navy Wing was submitted. Additionally, various extracurricular activities were conducted by the college, departments, and student cells.

Facilities were rated lower compared to other areas.

A new tuck shop was opened to meet student needs. The cleanliness standards of the canteen were upgraded to ensure a higher level of hygiene.
