College History & Profile

Amar Shaheed Baba Ajit Singh Jujhar Singh Memorial College, Bela was established in 1975 with the vision to provide quality Higher Education to the students of the rural area of Bela and its nearby villages. The institution is named after the 10th Guru Gobind Singh's elder sons; Sahibzada Ajit Singh and Sahibzada Jujhar Singh to commemorate their unmatched courage, exemplary valour, and supreme martyrdom attained by them in the battle of Chamkaur Sahib in 1704. They laid down their lives for the truth, righteousness, humanity, justice and protection of human rights to teach the coming generations to hold their heads high in the times of oppression, injustice, and tyranny. They are honoured with the honorifics of "Amar Shaheed", and the institution is an epitome of tribute that promises continue to take their legacy ahead with unwavering sincerity and faith. And we are privileged to witness its Golden Jubilee Years celebrations this year.

The College is situated in Village Bela which comes under Tehsil Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar, Punjab. It is located 15 km towards West from District head-quarters Rupnagar, 45 km from State capital Chandigarh. Bela is surrounded by Majri Tehsil towards South, Rupnagar Tehsil towards East, Morinda Tehsil towards South, Rupnagar, Kurali, Kharar are the nearby Cities to Bela. This Place is on the border of the Rupnagar District and Fatehgarh Sahib.

Historically Speaking, the village Bela was founded by S. Hardial Singh of Singhpuria Misal, Chief of Manauli State. His Descendent S. Umrao Singh donated his fort to construct this college when the idea of an HEI in this remote village was shared with him. The foundation stone of the college was laid down by Giani Zail Singh Ji (the then CM of Punjab who later on served as the President of India) on 6 February 1975 and since its inception, it proved itself to be a boon for the aspirants of Higher Education. The seeds of its foundation were sown by S. Gurbacahan Singh (then M.L.A.), Captain Gurbacahan Singh, S. Ajit Singh (Calcutta), S. Didar Singh, Pandit Kharaiti Lal, S. Harbans Singh, S. Lachhman Singh, S. Bakhtawar Singh and many others with great determination, commitment and dedication to bestow this area with an institution that will ensure a significant, enriching and unending journey of Higher Education. S. Gurbacahan Singh (the then M.L.A.) served it as its Founder President for 15 Years and navigated it towards the right directions of growth and achievements. The institution also acknowledges the financial assistance provided by Sant Baba Ajit Singh (Hansali Sahib) to construct its building. This district, this village and all the stakeholders shall always be grateful for the visionaries who gifted this institution to serve the mankind.

The college started its academic journey as five rooms building with 80 students on roll in the B.A. course. Today, it has nearly 1200 students enrolled in various courses and the institution offers 10 under-graduate courses, 07 Post-Graduate Courses and 2 Post-Graduate diploma courses. It is covered under Punjab Government's Grant-in-Aid scheme since 1978 and sections 2 (f) and 12 (B) of UGC in 1981. It has permanent affiliation to Punjabi University, Patiala and is an ISO certified institution. It is accredited by NAAC in 2012 and 2021 with B and B++ grade respectively. It is running NSDC launched "SKILL HUB" successfully in Food Processing. It is also recognised with "ONE DISTRICT ONE GREEN CHAMPION" award from MGNCRE, DHE, GOVT, of India. It is now approved by AICTE also and has implemented NEP 2020 as per the guidelines of the affiliating University.

The college is administered by the meticulous governance of Local Managing Committee (LMC) and the LMC has always prioritize the needs of the learners. This institution has spread its wings further and now it has become a group of institutes consisting College of Pharmacy with Autonomous Status, Maharani Satinder Kaur School Sen. Sec. School, and Kidzee School. It also provides the facility of separate hostel for boys and girls because its stature has started attracting the young bright minds and players from different corners of Punjab. The institution caters to the needs of all sections of the society and is focusing on the creation of skilled and employable youth. 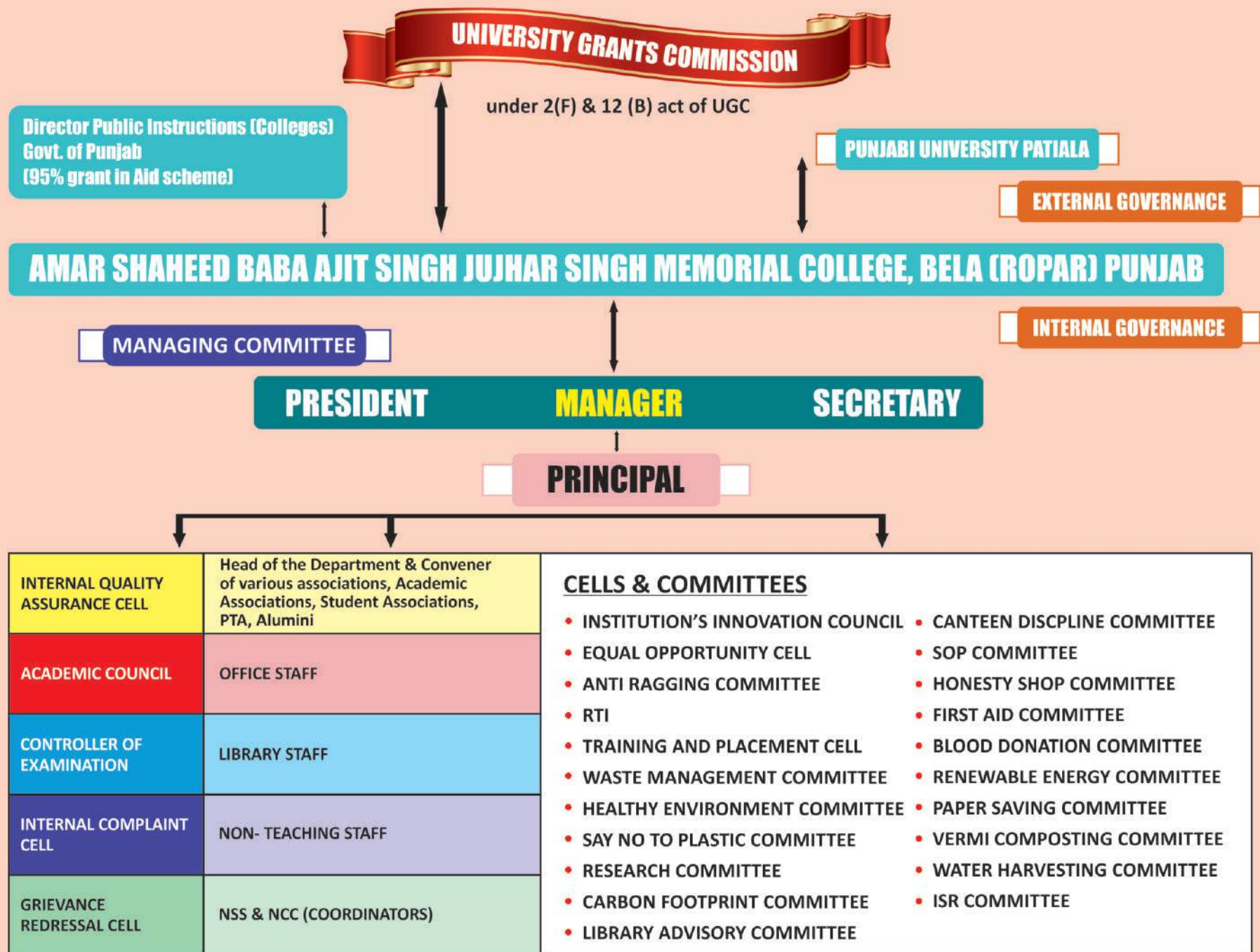

ADMISSION GUIDELINES

1. **Admission Criteria:** Admissions are based on merit and follow the rules of Punjabi University, Patiala, the Punjab Government, College Management, and UGC, New Delhi.
2. **Admission Form:** Fill out the online admission form (First Year Only) on the Punjab government admission portal. Also fill the admission form available at college. The admission will only be complete after the payment of college fee (First installment).
3. **Reservation of Seats:** Seats will be reserved according to the Punjab Government's Reservation Policy, rules of Punjabi University and UGC.
4. **Relaxation for Certain Categories:** Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and Physically Handicapped students (with a disability of at least 40%) are eligible for a 5% relaxation in the overall percentage.
5. **Migration Certificate:**
 - Students who have completed 10+2 from CBSE Board or any board other than the Punjab School Education Board are required to submit the original Migration Certificate.
 - Students, who have completed their graduation from any university other than Punjabi University, Patiala and are seeking admission in post-graduation course, must submit the Migration Certificate within one month of admission.
6. **Opting for 'Mudla Gyan':** As per Punjab Government rules, students may opt for 'Mudla Gyan' instead of the compulsory Punjabi subject, provided they meet the following conditions:
 - a) Students who have passed their Matriculation or 10+2 exams from outside Punjab and did not study Punjabi as a subject.
 - b) Children of Defence Personnel or Para Military Personnel.
 - c) Children of NRIs and foreign students.
7. **Changing Subject/Faculty:** A student may change subjects or faculties within 15 days from the commencement of classes, subject to seat availability.
8. **Re-appear Candidates:** Students with one re-appear in the 10+2 exam, are eligible to apply for admission to the 1st semester, subject to seat availability. They will receive provisional admission to the 1st year. However, re-appear exams must be cleared by the student before the 1st-year results are declared. If the relevant documents are not submitted by him/her before the result declaration, the admission will be automatically cancelled.
9. **Semester System Candidates:** Candidates who have completed their undergraduate courses under the semester system are eligible to apply for admission to Post-graduate Course, even if they have two re-appears in the 1st to 6th semesters. However, they must have passed the specific subject in their undergraduate course that they wish to pursue in the post-graduate course. Admission will be granted based on seat availability in the respective course.
10. **Attendance Requirement:** 75% attendance is compulsory for all the students. Apart from this, it is also mandatory for the first years students to have a regular attendance during the first week of the session to retain and continue their admission, otherwise it will result in the loss of the seat, and the fee will be forfeited. The seat will be offered to the next candidate on the merit list.
11. **Principal's Right:** The Principal can cancel or refuse admission to any student without giving a reason.
12. **Admission with False Information:** Admission obtained based on incorrect information or fake documents will be cancelled, and fee will be forfeited.
13. **Fee Refund:** Fee refunds will follow the UGC Notification. The specific refund rules will be applicable as follows:

%age of Refund of Fee	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received in the HEI
100%	15 days or more before the officially announced last date of admission
90%	Less than 15 days before the officially announced last date of admission
80%	15 days or less after the officially announced last date of admission

LIBRARY RULES

1. Students must carry their identity cards to access the college and library premises.
2. Each student is allowed to borrow up to two books at a time for a maximum period of 14 days.
3. A fine will be imposed for late book returns in accordance with Library regulation.
4. Magazines, reference books, dictionaries, and encyclopedias are for in-library use only and cannot be issued.
5. The librarian reserves the right to recall any issued book in case of urgent need.
6. Any lost or damaged books must be replaced by the student.
7. The library's internet facility is strictly for academic purposes only. Any misuse is prohibited.
8. Each book may be renewed only once.
9. Books that are either costly or available in a single copy will not be issued.
10. A Book-Bank facility is available for deserving and meritorious students.
11. All borrowed books must be returned at the end of the academic session before obtaining the 'No Dues' certificate from the college office.
12. Silence must be observed in the library at all times to ensure a peaceful study environment for all.
13. Students are expected to maintain cleanliness and not bring food or drinks into the library.
14. Bags and personal belongings must be left at the designated area near the entrance. The library is not responsible for any loss of personal items.
15. Furniture, equipment, and materials must be handled with care. Any damage must be reported immediately to the librarian.
16. Violation of library rules may lead to suspension of library privileges or further disciplinary action by the college authorities.

LEAVE RULES

1. Leave must be applied by students in advance using the prescribed form before any absence from the College.
2. In cases of medical emergencies where prior leave isn't possible, the leave application must be sent via email or post, or submitted immediately upon return. WhatsApp and text messages will not be accepted.
3. Prolonged absence due to illness must be supported by a medical certificate issued by a qualified doctor (minimum qualification: MBBS).
4. Continuous absence without a submitted leave application will be treated as a serious violation of College discipline.

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. **Prohibited Activities:** Drinking, smoking, and the use of drugs are strictly prohibited in the college campus.
2. **Absence:** A fine will be imposed for unapproved absences. If a student is absent for three consecutive days or is irregular for five days without permission, their name will be struck off from the college rolls.
3. **Mobile Phones:** Mobile phones are not allowed in classrooms, labs, library, or corridors. Misuse of mobile phones will result in a fine or further consequences.
4. **Social Media Misuse:** Sharing incorrect or offensive information about the college on social media can lead to disciplinary and legal action.
5. **Disciplinary Action:** The Principal can cancel the admission of any student on disciplinary grounds. Participating in or encouraging any disruptive movements or protests on campus will lead to punishment, suspension, or expulsion.
6. **Acts of Misconduct:** The following actions will result in disciplinary action:
 - Lack of courtesy, indecent behavior, or inappropriate dress on campus.
 - Misusing mobile phones on campus.
 - Damaging or defacing college property.
 - Hacking into computer systems or committing cybercrimes.
 - Mutilating or illegally keeping library books.
 - Accessing prohibited websites on college Wi-Fi or mobile phones.
 - Any other act of serious misconduct as decided by the Academic Council.
7. **Visitors:** Outsiders are not allowed on campus, except for parents or authorized guardians.
8. **Grievance Redressal:** The Grievance Redressal Committee, led by the Principal, will address any academic, administrative, or disciplinary issues. Students can submit complaints or suggestions in the suggestion boxes or approach the Dean of Students.
9. **Ragging:** Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited, both on campus and in the hostel. It is a punishable offense under the Supreme Court's direction. Students must follow the UGC anti-ragging guidelines.
10. **Anti-Ragging Affidavit:** Students and their parents must submit self-attested affidavits related to anti-ragging during admission.
11. **Internal Complaint Cell:** The Internal Complaint Cell will handle all complaints related to sexual harassment, and actions will follow the POSCO Act, 2012.
12. **Mentoring System:** A mentoring system is in place to help students connect with teachers for academic and personal guidance.
13. **Parent-Teacher Meetings:** PTA meetings are held twice a year—in the first week of September and the last week of April. Parents and guardians should attend regularly to discuss their ward's attendance and performance.
14. **Website Updates:** Students should regularly check the college website (www.belacollege.org) for updates on syllabi, exam dates, and other important information.

EXAMINATION RULES

GENERAL EXAMINATION RULES:

1. **Attendance Requirement:** Students must have at least 75% attendance to be eligible to sit in exams.
2. **Internal Assessment:** Regular submissions (assignments, projects, seminars, internal exams) contribute to internal assessment.
3. **Eligibility to Appear:**
 - (i) Students must clear fee dues and submit exam forms on time.
 - (ii) Student must submit duly signed No Dues Certificate (library, hostel, etc.) before issuance of an admit card.
4. **Passing Marks:** Students must score at least 35% in each subject to pass in Internal Assessment as well as External Examination for Theory and Practical examinations.

REAPPEAR EXAMINATIONS:

1. **Eligibility and Attempts:** Students placed under reappear in any paper are typically allowed two additional chances to clear the paper. These opportunities must be utilized within two consecutive years following the initial attempt, providing a total of three chances (including the first attempt) to pass the paper.
2. **Scheduling of Reappear Exams:** Reappear examinations for odd-semester papers are conducted alongside the regular odd-semester exams, and similarly, reappear exams for even-semester papers are held with the regular even-semester exams.
3. **Time Frame:** Students are required to fill Re-evaluation within 7 days from the declaration of result. Reappear forms are to be filled alongside regular examination of respective semester.

UNFAIR MEANS/MISCONDUCT/MALPRACTICES:

Unfair means include but are not limited to:

- Possession of unauthorized materials (notes, textbooks, electronic devices, etc.).
- Copying from another student or helping another student.
- Communicating with others during the examination without permission.
- Impersonation or arranging someone else to write the exam.
- Tampering with evaluated answer sheets.
- Creating disturbance in class.
- Use of prohibited digital tools (AI, calculators, phones, etc., when not allowed).

Depending on the severity, any of the following actions may be taken:

- Cancellation of the current paper (marks awarded = 0).
- Cancellation of all current semester papers.
- Debarment from examinations for one or more semesters.
- Expulsion from the college (for very serious cases like impersonation or repeated offenses).
- Registration of Criminal Case in case of threat, physical violence and carrying of firearms or any hazardous material.

GOLDEN CHANCE:

The "Golden Chance" is a special provision that allows students, who have exhausted their standard reappear attempts, an additional opportunity to clear their backlog papers. This chance is granted under specific conditions and is subject to the Principal's discretion.

IMPORTANT CONSIDERATIONS:

- **Application Process:** Students seeking to avail themselves of the Golden Chance must apply within the deadlines specified by the university/college. The application process may involve submitting forms and paying the requisite fees through designated modes such as e-payment, or cash at the college counter.
- **Fee Structure:** There may be specific fees associated with reappear and Golden Chance examinations, which are determined by the college and communicated during the application period.
